OUR HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOL



TEMPERATURE

All our staff have daily temperature checks before start working.



DEEP CLEANING

Each unit is guaranteed to be thoroughly disinfected before leaving for service.



DAILY CLEANING RECORD

Drivers verify that the transport unit has the daily cleaning record, also a record of cleaning products used.



INFORMATION

Tour guides and drivers must guard a safe social distance and inform passengers about the protocols that must be followed during the service.



PRODUCTS DISINFECTANTS

Clients will have guaranteed access to hand sanitizer, disinfectant rug when entering the units, disposable towels for hand drying.



MASK MANDATORY

It is mandatory that before beginning the service, all passengers have their own facemasks (cloth or acrylic).



DO NOT SHARE ARTICLES

Staff will not share personal belongings and avoid handling or contact with passenger belongings.



DISINFECT SURFACES

Continuously touched surfaces should will be cleaned and disinfected, with special emphasis on handles, rails, belts, seats, the driver's cab, dashboards, mirrors, windows, and others.



DISINFECT LUGGAGE

The driver must disinfect the passenger's luggage before introducing it to the transport unit with a sprayer with authorized cleaning product.



SYMPTOMS OF THE VIRUS

Clients should not show to the activity if they show symptoms of the Covid-19 virus such as cough, sore throat, fever, or breathing difficulty. If a passenger shows any of these symptoms, they will not be able to board the vehicle.



PROTECTION FOR DRIVERS AND GUIDES

During the transfer or excursion, drivers must wear a mask and glasses. As for tour guides or operating personnel, should use an acrylic mask or mask with glasses.

RAINFOREST HANGING BRIDGES & WILDLIFE SANCTUARY



NATURE & CONSERVATION

Rainforests are mostly known for the vast numbers of species that live within them. The diversity of trees, plants, insects, and wildlife is unmatched by any other ecological zone. More than half of the flora and fauna interactions take place a hundred feet or more off the ground in the canopy.

Along the 1.55 miles (2.5km) of trails and three hanging bridges, you will learn how every tree, ferns, mosses, and exotic vegetation such as bromeliads and orchids compete for any space and light in the rain forest.

Then, visit Las Pumas Rescue Center & Wildlife Sanctuary where the guide will explain everything about rescuing, rehabilitating, researching, and releasing wild species back into the wildlife. The wildlife sanctuary is also home to animals that could not return to their habitats because of some reason.


It provides a quality captivity life for wild cats, monkeys, white-tailed deer, peccaries, and three species of parrots, scarlet macaw, and keel-billed toucan.

Enjoy a comfortable river cruise expedition through the Palo Verde Wetlands which navigates slowly down the margins of the Tempisque River in search of wildlife.

Visit an old-style “hacienda” built-in 1881 and learn the entire rum-making process.

Sugar cane is an extremely important crop of Guanacaste, thanks to its tropical climate, fertile soils, and the development of advanced technologies.

The educational Tour represents the hard-working spirit of the Guanacaste cowboys, known as “sabaneros”.

The Tropical Rainforest is surrounded by exuberant vegetation and wildlife.

Experience the Real Guanacaste Culture, history, and traditions. Visit a historical hacienda to learn about the culture and history of Costa Rica.

The spectacular Arenal Volcano National Park lies in the northern highlands of Costa Rica. Tourists from all over the world who have visited this destination have been amazed by its perfect conic shape.

This excursion allows you to experience adventure and adrenaline in a private reserve located in an extensive tropical forest, which offers magnificent panoramic views of the Arenal Volcano and the beautiful Lake Arenal.

You will enjoy the Gondolas that rise smoothly through the rainforest and the thrilling zip lines that go from one mountain to another while you fly in the cables at 200m (656ft) in height and 750m (2460ft) in length and speeds that go up to 70km/h (43.5mph).

The excursion is complemented by the relaxing hot springs, which flow directly from the base of this imposing volcano and are surrounded by tropical gardens.

Visit one of the seven wonders of Costa Rica: The Mighty Arenal Volcano. This iconic destination lies in the northern highlands of Costa Rica, its perfect shape cone (over 5,430 ft) is visible on clear days.

At the Hanging Bridges, explore in a 2 hours walk from heights the richness of the rainforest and discover the hidden secrets of wildlife.

Indulge yourself in the relaxing thermal springs surrounded by tropical gardens. Hot springs become very beneficial to your body, thanks to their temperature that helps to relax muscles, clean pores, and rejuvenate the skin.

TREASURES OF MONTEVERDE CLOUD FOREST



Monteverde has been recognized as an ecotourism destination thanks to its protected cloud forests, rich in tropical flora and fauna. It is located in the Tilarán Mountain Range, approximately 4662 ft above sea level.

Along a 1.5 hour walk in the Cloud Forest, you will feel the fresh breeze and listen to hundreds of sounds of the natural world. The aerial tram and Hanging Bridges offer the possibility to admire emerald-green foliage like mosses, ferns bromeliads, and orchids.

Monteverde is also a great destination to experience the culture. You will visit a family-run business and learn all about the traditional methods of processing the crops of Coffee, Chocolate, and sugar plantations.

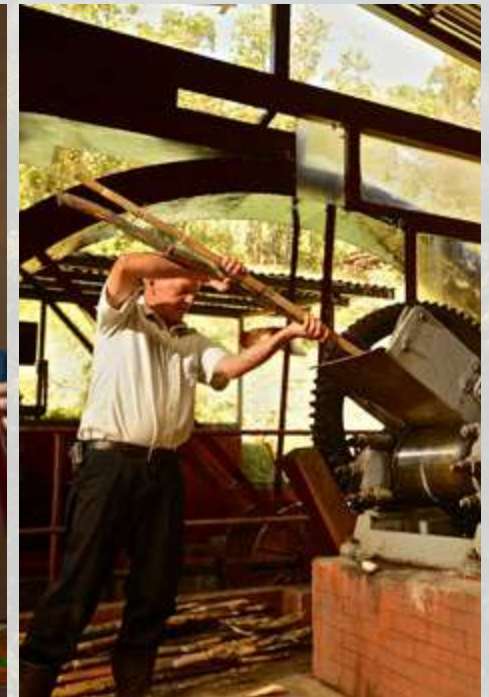

RIO PERDIDO: Zip Lines, Tubing & Hot Springs



ADVENTURE & RELAX

Located in the beautiful region of Bagaces, right at the base of the Miravalles Volcano, there is a sacred place for the ancient indigenous tribes that inhabited this area hundreds of years ago.

This tourist complex has been developed in the middle of two rivers; the Rio Blanco is the place for adventure activities: Ziplines with lengths varying from 260 to over 800ft and platforms, some suspended on the canyon walls.

Adrenaline is combined with a pendulum cable, a 50ft “Tarzan swing, a 90ft challenge bridge & a climbing route.

Have fun at the Tubbing! Just sit back on the tire and let the turbulent current of the river do the rest!!


At the Rio Perdido, you will relax at the natural hot springs in the crystal-clear river with different temperatures and surrounded by 28 ancestral trees.

RINCON DE LA VIEJA NATIONAL PARK HIKE



NATURE

The Rincon de la Vieja National Park is the only active volcano in the Guanacaste Mountain Range, their volcanic elements can be found right in their surroundings.

A 3-hour hike at Las Pailas trail will allow you to see bubbling volcanic muds, steamy sulfur water ponds, and some fumaroles, along with beautiful sceneries with open fields for perfect pictures.

The abundance of habitats makes this area one of the most ecologically diverse refuges in Guanacaste, make it a wildlife paradise for Monkeys, Sloths, and dozen of birds.

ZIP LINES & WILDLIFE SANCTUARY PROJECT



ADVENTURE & CONSERVATION

Visit a park well-known for its exciting Zip Line course featuring the longest dual-action zip line in the country. Adventure Circuit includes five zip-lines with one of the longest cables (almost a mile) and Superman cable, a Walking bridge, and a Quick Jump: Free fall down a 30-foot tower.

The park is home to a renowned Animal Sanctuary and one of the most beautiful Wildlife Education Centers in Costa Rica.

You will learn the importance of preserve the ecosystems for birds, monkeys, sloths, and reptiles.

PALO VERDE WETLANDS



Located between Tempisque and Bebedero rivers; Palo Verde National Park is one of the most important wildlife sanctuaries of the Guanacaste region.

With more than 45 thousand acres of protected lands, there are a significant number of aquatic ecosystems, where life develops with exuberance. Not in vain, it has been declared one of the most beautiful wetlands of international importance because of its exceptional ecological value.

During this 2 hours boat expedition, you explore the mangroves and tropical jungle while the professional guide will be very attentive to show you some of the wildlife species that used to approximate to the riverbanks in search of their food.

GUANACASTE ZIP LINES



The Canopy Tour is one of the most popular adventure activities in Costa Rica.

This exciting activity consists of a series of cables with distances ranging from 350mts (1150ft) to 800mts (2625ft) and platforms with heights up to 30mts (100ft). You will be gliding in a fun way from one side to another, reaching speeds from 25-30 km/h. (15-20 mi/h)


While you are “Flying” above in the upper parts of the dry forest, you will admire the lush forest from the treetops, providing you a different perspective of the ecosystems and the beautiful landscapes of Guanacaste.

SURF LESSONS



Surfing is a popular water activity, where wave riders stand up on a surfboard, which glides across the water's surface until the wave breaks upon the shore and loses its energy.

Costa Rica is one of the top surfing destinations in the world to learn surfing. With an average water temperature of 84 degrees and consistent waves throughout the year, Guanacaste has excellent surf breaks for first-timers.

Surfing is a sport with multiple interpretations, some people consider it just a recreational activity, physical activity, and a competitive sport, but for others, it is almost a religion, a lifestyle, an addiction, and a spiritual connection with Nature.


A professional instructor will introduce you to the surfing fundamentals, etiquette, safety, wave dynamics, paddling skills, surfboard positioning, maneuvering, proper stand-up, and riding techniques.


After some minutes of practice, you will stand up on the surfboard and
41 enjoy the thrilling sensation of surfing over the waves.
